On September 13<sup>th</sup>, 2005, the Manitoba Sports Hall of Fame & Museum announced its inductee slate for the upcoming Annual Dinner. The 26<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Induction will take place at the Canad Inns Polo Park on Saturday, November 5<sup>th</sup>, 2005.

Those being honoured include 4 Athletes, 3 Builders, 1 Team, a Veteran Athlete and a Veteran Team. It's another exceptional year for fans of the Winnipeg Blue Bombers. CFL All-Star Lineman **Roger Savoie** will be honoured as the Veteran Athlete while the

"Lincoln Locomotive" **Leo Lewis** (see photo) joins him in the Athlete category. Brandon amateur football fans will also be thrilled that **Doug Steeves** is to be honoured in the Builder category. The other 3 deserving athletes include Weightlifting/ Athletics Champion **Theresa Brick**, NHL Ironman **Grant Ledyard** for Hockey and Archery's first inductee, National 3-D Champion **Marcel Mangin** (see photo).

We also honour All Round Builder **Don MacKenzie** for his work with Hockey, the MSF and the 1999 Pan Am Games, and **Marjorie Simpson**, an International Judge and lifelong volunteer in Synchronized Swimming.

The Veteran Team induction honours the Basketball

dynasty of the **1952 & 53 Winnipeg Light Infantry**, back-to-back Junior Canadian Champions. We also honour the 3 Avco Cup Champions of the Winnipeg Jets' glory days in the World Hockey Association with the **1976,78 & 79 Winnipeg Jets**.

The Dinner Committee, chaired by **Patrick Riddell**, hopes for 800 people to come out and celebrate our 26<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. Tickets are only \$87.50, a portion of which is tax deductible, and are available at the Hall of Fame offices at 200 Main Street or by calling 925-5735.

The membership now stands at 182 Athletes, 96 Builders and 64 Teams as 2005 draws to a close. Here are the highlights of Collection Manager **Andrea Earl’s** Year End Report from April/2004 – March/2005:

- 62 accessions of artifacts & archival material
- A major donation of Winnipeg Jets Material, including the actual Avco Cup, game worn jerseys and equipment... all of which was catalogued by Christian Egan
- All “old loans” were cleared up and processed into the collection
- The 1999 Pan Am Games material (held on-site since the Games) was returned to the City of Winnipeg until ownership issues can be resolved... we hope some of it will return in the future
- The MB Junior Hockey League purchased storage/transport boxes for 4 of the 6 MJHL trophies that they borrow annually for awards ceremonies
- Chris Egan completed archival collection work for all material preceding 2000 and it now has fonds descriptions & file/list items
- We processed almost 40 research requests from the public
